

# Download Manual Radiology Technique Chart

Technique Charts. A technique chart is a listing of the various radiographic examinations performed in the facility. It provides exposure factors for each body part according to its thickness. Table 10-1 is an example of a portion of a manual exposure technique chart. It is called manual because each technical factor is set “manually” by the x-ray operator.
