2. Identify Objectives for Teaching The Maze Runner: Identify elements of dystopian fiction apparent in The Maze Runner. Trace how characters' goals and motivations evolve throughout the novel. Discuss the symbolic significance of the Maze, the Glade, the Box, and the sun.

The Maze Runner trilogy is part of a growing body of literature in recent years that has been called "postapocalyptic" or "dystopian." Discuss the meaning of these terms and compare the Maze Runner trilogy to similar novels you may have read—the Books of Ember series by Jeanne DuPrau or the Hunger Games series by Suzanne Collins.

The Maze Runner Study Guide. The Maze Runner was written by James Dashner following the success of The Jimmy Fincher Saga. Although his publisher had pressed Dashner to write another book in the series, Dashner decided to try to reach a larger market with new material. He conceived of a story in which children are led into a large maze full of deadly traps and puzzles. Please note that this lesson plan focuses only on the first book of The Maze Runner series. Students who have read the whole series may have additional insights and opinions based on The Scorch Trials and The Death Cure or the prequels The Kill Order and The Fever Code, but try to encourage them to ...

At the beginning of The Maze Runner, Thomas arrives in a place called the Glade, run by teenage boys, with no memory of their former lives. He becomes one of a special group mapping the Maze that surrounds the Glade. When Teresa, the only girl, arrives soon after Thomas, everything begins to change.
