A medical laboratory assistant is an integral member of the laboratory workforce, a field that is not only growing to meet the needs of an increasing and aging population but also changing to support medical and technological advances. As seen with most health care occupations, clinical medical assistants (CMAs) who are specially trained in a single area of medicine experience greater prospects for advancement, higher salary, and work security throughout their careers. A medical laboratory scientist (MLS), also traditionally referred to as a medical technologist (MT) or clinical laboratory scientist (CLS), is a healthcare professional who performs chemical, hematological, immunologic, histopathological, cytopathological, microscopic, and bacteriological diagnostic analyses on body fluids such as blood, urine, sputum, stool, cerebrospinal fluid (CSF ...
