For example, the exhibition of works of art or a movie may require a license from a government authority (sometimes referred to a classification board or censorship board) before it can be published, and the failure or refusal to grant a license is a form of censorship as is the revoking of a ...This did not alter the meaning of the constitution, although if there is a case where meaning is ambiguous, the original document remains the final authority. The earlier wording of the constitution, including all of the amendments approved since adoption in 1857, is printed in the *Minnesota Legislative Manual 1973-74*, pages 445-484.
